- If your most recent mammogram was done at another facility, please bring your films with you or have them
 forwarded to us before your appointment. Please allow one to two weeks for the mail service. We compare your
 previous films to the current exam. If your films are not here at the time of your mammogram, your final report may
 be delayed until this comparison is made.
- Please schedule your mammogram after your period if possible. This will minimize breast discomfort during the
 examination. It is advisable to avoid scheduling during the time you might have premenstrual or cyclical hormone
 related breast tenderness.
- Do not wear body powders, deodorant, lotions or sprays. They may contain substances that can show up as an artifact on the mammogram pictures.
- Because you will be asked to undress from the waist up for this procedure, it is best to wear a blouse or sweater rather than a dress to your appointment.
